



Mastering the Art of Fly Fishing

Gear List for Warm Weather

- Hat(s)- whatever style you prefer to keep the sun out of your eyes and off your face
- Breathable layers- may need long sleeves for sun protection and warmth in the morning, and short sleeves for midday heat
- Quick dry pants and/or shorts- you will wear pants or shorts underneath your waders, be sure they are comfortable and made of quick drying material (not denim) in case they get wet
- Light socks- you will wear socks in your waders, choose a light, breathable style
- Shoes- you will mostly be in waders and boots, but easy to remove shoes are helpful when you have to change out at the river
- Light rain jacket- thunderstorms are not uncommon here in the mountains, and a light jacket you can put in your vest or pack is a good idea
- Fleece jacket or sweatshirt- mornings can be chilly, so a jacket or sweatshirt is helpful
- Backpack/knapsack/tote (small)- bring something to store extra clothes and gear in for day trips, especially if you need medications or other items close at hand.
- Sunscreen
- Lip balm
- Hand lotion
- Polarized sunglasses- for spotting fish and cutting glare on the water
